SIGNATURE PROJECT CONTEST

The <u>2024 Signature Project Contest</u> will recognize the most innovative and impactful signature projects from Kiwanis clubs around the world. Clubs can submit their projects from January 2-25.

Clubs with 27 members or fewer will be evaluated in Group I. Clubs with 28 members or more will be evaluated in Group II. The top 10 and top three finalists in each group will be recognized at the 2024 Kiwanis International Convention.

This year, we are excited to announce monetary awards for the top three finalists in each group: **US\$1,000** for bronze winners, **US\$1,500** for silver winners and **US\$2,000** for gold winners.

Remember, signature projects:

- Are recurring. (Note: A new project can qualify as a signature project if the intent is to continue the project.)
- Enhance the Kiwanis image.
- Show significant impact on the community.
- Strengthen membership and partnership opportunities.
